Village of Oregon's Planning Commission to hold Public Forum on Proposed Village's Master Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan

May 7, 2009 at 6:00 p.m. –Open House

May 7, 2009 at 6:30 p.m. –Public Forum

On May 7, 2009 the Village of Oregon's Planning Commission will present the proposed Master Bicycle/Pedestrian Plan prepared by Vandewalle and Associates. The Planning Commission will hold a public forum at 6:30pm to receive comments and input on the proposed plan. Vandewalle and Associates will also be available at an Open House from 6:00pm to 6:30pm prior to the public forum. The goal of the plan is to provide a framework for developing a network of connecting trails that will be developed within and outside the Village. The trails would be developed through public funding and future private developments.

The Village has heard from residents that they would like to see a bicycle connection into the City of Madison. The plan is proposing to use the rail corridor between Oregon and Fitchburg as a route into the City of Madison by connecting to the Capital/City Trail.

There is a large display board outside the Village Hall Clerk's Office on the second floor showing the proposed plan and residents are encouraged to also go to the Village's web page at www.vil.oregon.wi.us and click under Proposed Master Bicycle/Pedestrian plan to view the proposed plan. The public is encouraged to attend the May 7th Planning Commission meeting and provide their input to the Village.
