RE: New Brush & Yard Waste Drop Off Site Now Open

The new brush and yard waste drop off site located just south of the Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) at 91 North Perry Parkway is now open. The new site allows for a one-way in and one-way out traffic flow pattern which should greatly improve efficiency during busy drop off times. Please help us keep this area looking nice by following certain guidelines:

- 1) Please **DO** follow the signage showing the entrance/exit and traffic flow routes.
- 2) Please **DO** look for signage to indicate the locations for brush drop off and yard waste.
- 3) Please **DO** place yard waste and brush as far back on the gravel area as possible allowing room for others.
- 4) Please **DO** be patient with people as they drop off items.
- 5) Please **DON'T** place material on the asphalt surfaces.
- 6) Please **DON'T** place items which shouldn't be dumped (e.g. concrete, rocks, construction waste, plastic, etc.)

This site is for **VILLAGE OF OREGON RESIDENTS ONLY** and is not to be used by contractors or those outside of the Village. Contractors and non-residents have and will be ticketed and fined.
