## **\*\*Press Release\*\***

January 20, 2023 – At 8:17 p.m. Oregon Police responded to 213 Walnut Street in the Village of Oregon for a male subject who was threatening to kill a man and his family. As officers arrived on scene, the suspect fled into his apartment.

From inside of the residence, the suspect made threats to kill officers and the Oregon K9. The male subject eventually complied with requests to come out of his apartment, and he was taken into custody without incident. No one was injured.

Tracey Nelson, who is 60 years of age from Oregon, Wisconsin, was arrested and tentatively charged with Criminal Damage to Property, Harassment of a Police Animal, Threats to a Law Enforcement Officer, and three counts of Disorderly Conduct.

Pursuant to the directive of the Wisconsin Supreme Court as found in Supreme Court Rule 20:3.6, Trial Publicity, you are advised that a charge is merely an accusation, and the defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty.
